

District Youth Parliament 2019

Giridih College ,Giridih is organizing District Youth Parliament for Giridih and Koderma Dist. On 28th January, 2019

➤ **OBJECTIVES OF ORGANIZING YOUTH PARLIAMENT FESTIVAL**

1. To hear the voice of youth between 18 and less than 25 yrs of age, who are allowed to vote but cannot stand as a candidate for election.
2. To encourage the youth to engage with public issues, understand the common man's point of view, form their opinion and express it in an articulate manner.
3. To develop and enhance decision making abilities.
4. To obtain and document their opinions on vision of new India in 2022.

➤ **CRITERIA FOR PARTICIPATION**

1. Youth to participate in District Youth parliament must be above 18 and less than 25 years of age as on 30th June 2018.
2. Proof of age in original and a photocopy is to be carried by the participant during the walk in screening. As an age proof certificates such as class 10 certificate, birth certificate, passport, voter ID card, driving license, pan card, adhaar card. A copy of the certificate is to be provided to the organizers.
3. The individual need not necessarily be a student of an educational institution to participate in the Youth Parliament.

➤ **Selection Process**

1. **Digital Process :** 12th to 18th January, 2019

Individuals have to record their speech of 90-120 seconds on any one of the given subjects and upload the video on YouTube. The participants will register at MyGov site (innovate.mygov.in/youth-parliament), provide information and then provide link of You Tube video.

The Evaluation criteria for Digital Screening to select participants for district Youth Parliaments is given below:

- a. Articulation/Eloquence
- b. Content knowledge
- c. Clarity of Thought

Each of the above criteria will carry 30 points. Maximum of 50 participants in order of merit will be selected.

➤ **Walk in Process: 17th to 19th January 2019**

Individual Candidates can walk-in and appear for screening at Giridih College, Giridih from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. from 17th to 19th January 2019 at Faculty Building. Screening of youth will be done by a 2 member screening committee by hearing 2 to 3 minutes on the subject matter.

Evaluation criteria for selecting participants through walk-in for District Youth parliament as given below:

- a) Articulation
- b) Content knowledge
- c) Clarity of Thought
- d) Demeanor

Each evaluation criteria will carry 25 points with maximum 100 points. Maximum of 50 participants will be selected in order of merit by screening.
